

Catherine's Miniature Schnauzers

Written Health Guarantee

1. The purchaser must have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within Three (3) business days of the arrival, or pick up date.
2. The puppy is guaranteed until one (1) year of age against fatal and life altering congenital and genetic disease which adversely affects the health of the animal.
3. I, Catherine Betts, must be notified of the problem within two (2) business days of the licensed veterinarian's determination and have two (2) reports from two (2) different veterinarians stating the same problem. I will provide a replacement puppy of equivalent value when the next litter is available. The original puppy must be returned to me. Purchaser is responsible for the transportation cost of the original puppy and the replacement puppy.
4. I will not be responsible for veterinarian fees or cost. Purchaser is aware that owning a puppy means trips to the veterinarian and understands that he/she will be responsible for all payments.
5. There is no guarantee or warranty that covers any complications arising from breeding the puppy should breeding occur before one year of age.
6. Purchaser is required to keep the puppy current on all veterinarian care including shots and dewormings. I recommend keeping the new puppy separate from other dogs in the family until the veterinarian has given it a clean bill of health.
7. Ear cropping, if desired, is done at the purchaser's expense after the puppy leaves the breeder. Purchaser takes all responsibility for health complications resulting from cropping.
